- notified in early May of their selection. Awards will be presented at the International Snowmobile Congress in June. The Club of the Year will be submitted to the International Snowmobile Hall of Fame for the International Snowmobile Club of the Year award.
- Additionally the Groomer of the Year will be submitted by April 1, to the
  International Groomer Operator of the Year program which was developed with the
  cooperation of the International Snowmobile Hall of Fame and Arctic Cat. There is a
  separate submission process and the names Groomer of the Year and CSA will work
  with the original nominator to complete the submission.
